4. SNOWBOARDING VENUE

A. Introduction to the Venue

Palandöken Ski Resort

3.271m Palandöken Mountain is 4km from the city center. The competitions of Snowboarding and Freestyle Skiing will be held in this resort.

Snowboarding Competition Venues

All the Snowboarding competition venues are located within Palandöken Ski Resort.

Parallel Giant Slalom Venue

This course is 567 meters long and 60 meters wide with a vertical drop of 152 meters and an average steepness of 28%.

Snowboard Cross Venue

This course is 734 meters long and 30-50 meters wide with a vertical drop of 178 meters and an average steepness of 25%.

Half Pipe Venue

This course is 172 meters long, 5.8 meters high with a width lip to lip (WLTL) of 18 meters, with a width bottom section (WB) of 5 meter sand an average steepness of 17.5%.

Slope Style Venue

This course is 744 meters long and 20-30 meters wide with a vertical drop of 187 meters and an average steepness of 26%.

B. Transportation Services

Erzurum 2011 OC guarantees that transportation services will be provided for all accredited persons of the 25th Winter Universiade.

Different Services are guaranted for different clients and the service can change day by day due to the competition schedule.

5. GENERAL RULES

A. Participation

Art 5.1 (FISU Regulations)

Only the following may take part in the Winter Universiade:

- a) an association with membership of FISU;
- b) in the case of non-affiliation to FISU:

1. A country whose Olympic Committee is allowed to take part in the Olympic Games;
2. A country not having an Olympic Committee recognized by the IOC may take part in those sports for which there is a FSN of that country which is affiliated to the ISF. The Executive Committee will take a decision for each sport in which country wishes to participate.

Art 5.2.1 (FISU Regulations)

Only the following may participate as competitors in the Winter Universiade:

- a) Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
- b) Former students of the institutions mentioned in a) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

Art 5.2.2 (FISU Regulations)

Notwithstanding Article 5.2.1, in countries with fewer than 2.000.000 inhabitants or having fewer than 5.000 University students, students attending technical or secondary schools may participate in FISU events provided that they have been attending their establishments for at least two (2) years.

Countries wishing to take advantage of the concession in the first paragraph of Article 5.2.2 must submit an application to the FISU Executive Committee at least six (6) months before the scheduled start of the event. Such an application must be supported by documents endorsed by the appropriate State or National Academic Authorities.

Art 5.2.3 (FISU Regulations)

All competitors must satisfy the following conditions:

- a) be a national of the country they represent;
- b) be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on January 1st in the year of the event. (2011 WU Erzurum-The participants must have been born between January 1st, 1983 and December 31st, 1993)

B. Entries

According to the Article 5.4.6 of the FISU Regulations, each National University Sport Federation, or other organizations as specified in Art.5.1.2, must submit to the Organizing Committee the official entry following the marked deadlines:

After these deadlines neither changes nor additional entries will be accepted.

C. Insurance

The participating countries must have the appropriate insurance to cover travel and participation, as they are the responsibility of neither the Organizing Committee nor FISU (art. 5.8.3).

Participating countries must therefore have insurance for the medical care of the whole delegation. Only first aid procedures related to the Games will be covered by the OC and just for accredited persons.

D. Medical Services

The Organizing Committee insures:

- a) free adequate medical assistance for the FISU family, participants and all accredited persons during the Winter Universiade.
- b) doping control in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 14, if requested by the FIS.

6. COMPETITION RULES

The Snowboarding competitions will be organized in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the Federation Internationale de Ski (FIS). In any dispute, the English text will be regarded as authoritative, (art. 12.30.1)

Any protest against a sport nature or disciplinary nature must reach the jury through the referee or other competent officials according to the regulations laid down by the appropriate FIS or by the technical regulations, (art. 11.2)

A Head of Delegation or his deputy has recourse to protest against the decision of the Jury. This protest must be submitted in written form to the Jury of Appeal in accordance with the regulations of the appropriate FIS. Such protest must be accompanied by a deposit of fifty (50) EUR which will be returned if the protest is considered to be justified, (art. 11.3)

Any decision of the Jury of Appeal of a sport is final one and must be reported immediately to the Head of Delegation of the country concerned, (art. 11.4)

Protests allowed in Article (3.2.2 d) must be presented to the President or the General Secretary of FISU, by the Head of Delegation or his deputy in written form not later than six hours after the incident (art. 3.2.7)

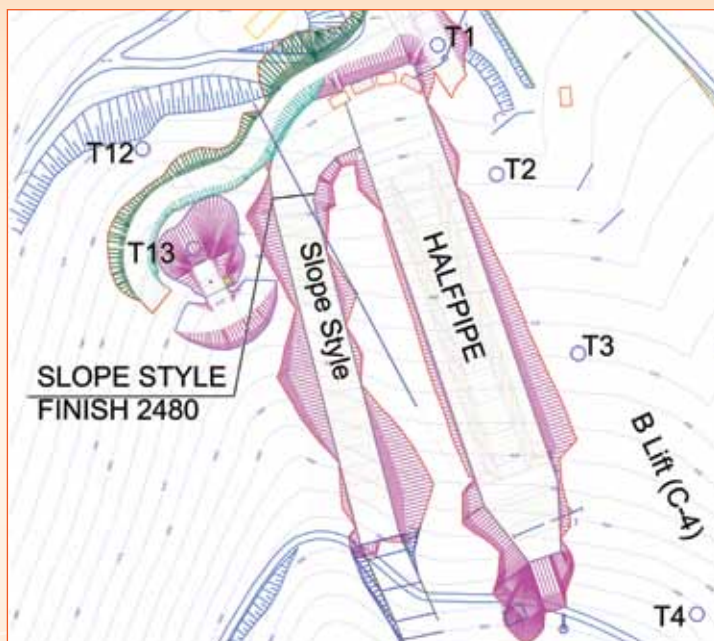

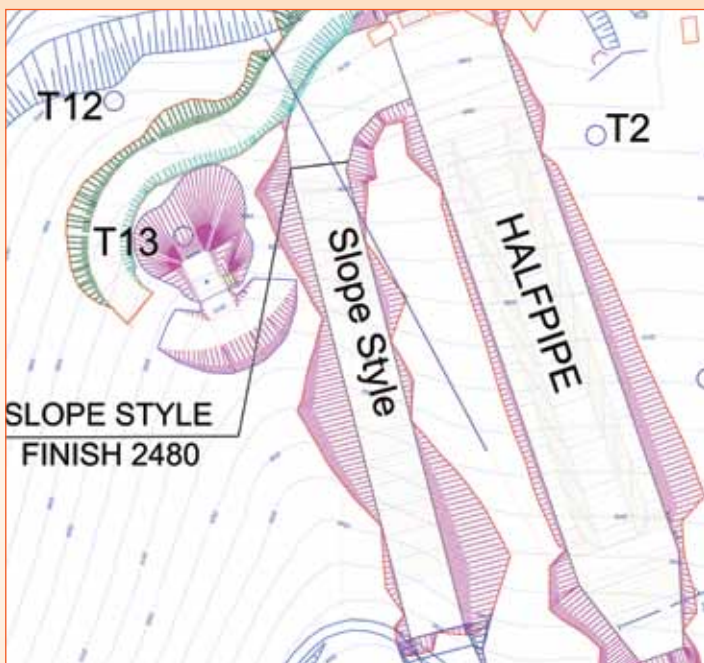
Layout of Palandöken Ski Resort

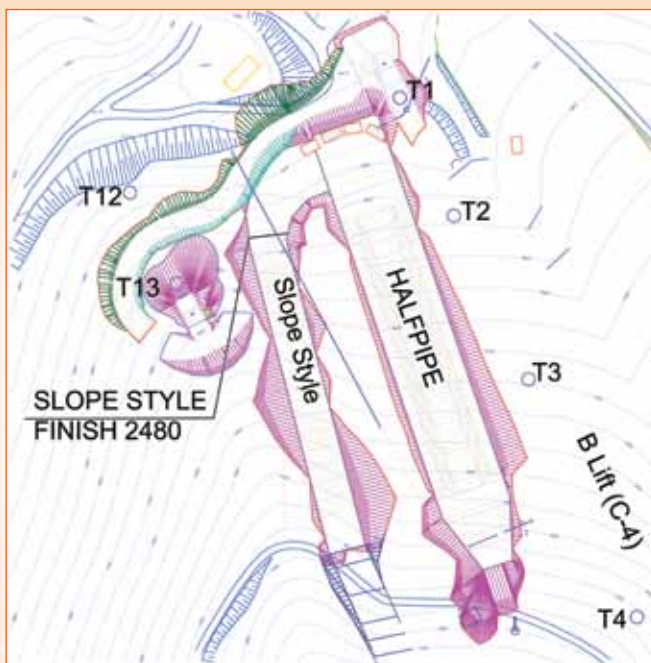
Map of Slope Style

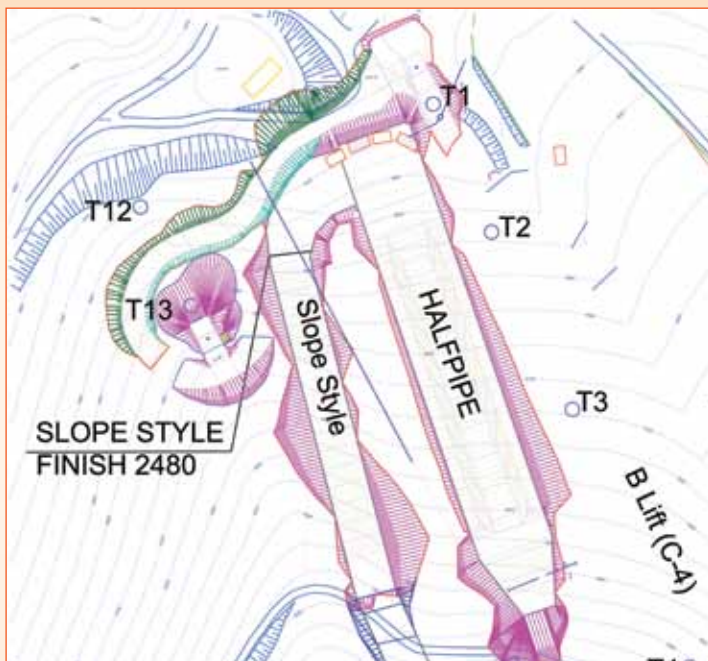
Map of SBX
