4. FIGURE SKATING AND SYNCHRONIZED SKATING VENUE

A. Introduction to the Venue

Erzurum indoor Ice Skating Rink (30x60m) was built and opened in March 9th 2009 in the downtown city. It has a construction area of 6.000m² with a seating capacity of 2.000. The rink has suitable facilities including locker rooms, lounges, medical room, doping control room and enough official rooms for the technical panel, judges and officials. It has hosted national figure skating competitions many times.

There is a Practice Ice Rink in the same area. The official practices will take place in both ice rinks. Both rinks are indoor and heated.

B. Transportation Services

Erzurum 2011 OC guarantees transportation service for all accredited persons of the 25th Winter Universiade.

Different services are guaranteed for different disciplines and persons. The service can change day by day due to the competition schedule.

For information regarding the athletes' transportation services, schedules and timetables, please refer to the Transportation Manual.

5. GENERAL RULES

A. Participation

Art 5.1 (FISU Regulations)

Only the following may take part in the Winter Universiade:

- a) an association with membership of FISU;
- b) in the ease of non-affiliation to FISU:

1. A country whose Olympic Committee is allowed to take part in the Olympic Games;
2. A country not having an Olympic Committee recognized by the IOC may take part in those sports for which there is a TSF of that country which is affiliated to the ISF. The Executive Committee will take a decision for each sport in which country wishes to participate;

Art 5.2.1 (FISU Regulations)

Only the following may participate as competitors in the Winter Universiade:

- a) Students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
- b) Former students of the institutions mentioned in a) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

Art 5.2.2 (FISU Regulations)

Notwithstanding Article 5.2.1, in countries with fewer than 2.000.000 inhabitants or having fewer than 5.000 University students, students attending technical or secondary schools may participate in FISU events provided that they have been attending their establishments for at least two (2) years.

Countries wishing to take advantage of the concession in the first paragraph of Article 5.2.2 must submit an application to the FISU Executive Committee at least six (6) months before the scheduled start of the event. Such an application must be supported by documents endorsed by the appropriate State or National Academic Authorities.

Art 5.2.3 (FISU Regulations)

All competitors must satisfy the following conditions:

- a) be a national of the country they represent;
- b) be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on January 1st in the year of the event. (2011 WU Erzurum – The participants must have been born between January 1st, 1983 and December 31st, 1993)

B. Judges and Referees/Art. 12.31.4 (FISU Regulations)

Each country participating in Figure Skating and Synchronized Skating must inform FISU and the OC the name (s) and category of their proposed International or ISU Judges at latest six (6) months (Reg. Art.5.3.1) before the start of the Winter Universiade. The OC will send the list of nominated Judges to ISU and FISU CTI for their final decision regarding the composition of the Judges Panel for each category.

If the names are not received by this time six (6) months before the start of Winter Universiade, the OC in accordance with ISU and FISU CT, shall have the right to arrange for substitute Judges. The OC will inform all participating countries about the Judges Panel for each category.

Each participating country in which they have skaters in more than two (2) disciplines may send maximum two (2) Judges. Exceptions will be given to the organizing country (Judges in all categories) and countries competing in Synchronized Skating.

Referees and Technical Panel (Technical Specialists and Controllers) as well as Data and Replay Operators will be appointed by the OC after approval from ISU and the Chair of the Technical Committee of FISU.

The total amount of the Judges' and Referees' costs for their stay and travel will be divided according to the number of participants and all countries will pay pro rata to the number of their participants (skaters and number of the teams).

The OC will fix the sum after deadline for the Quantitative Entries three (3) months before the start of the Winter Universiade.

The Technical Panel expenses will be the responsibility of the Organizing Committee. It consists of Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists (for Men, Women, Pairs, Ice Dance, and Synchronized Skating) as well as Data operator, Video operator and Cameraman.

The Referees, Judges and Technical Panel, Data Operator, Video Operator must be invited by the OC not less than three (3) months before the start of the Winter Universiade.

C. Entries

According to the Article 5.4.6 of the FISU Regulations, each National University Sports Federation, or other organizations as specified in Art.5.1.2, must submit to the Organizing Committee the official entry following the marked deadlines:

D. Insurance

The participating countries must have the appropriate insurance to cover travel and participation, as they are the responsibility of neither the Organizing Committee nor FISU (art. 5.8.3).

Participating countries must therefore have insurance for the medical care of the whole delegation. Only first aid procedures related to the Games will be covered by the OC and only for accredited persons.

E. Medical Service

The Organizing Committee insures:

- a) free adequate medical assistance for the FISU family, participants and all accredited persons during the Universiade;
- b) doping control in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 14, if requested by the ISU

6. COMPETITION RULES

The event will be organized in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU). In any dispute the English text will be regarded as authoritative (art. 12.30.1).

Any protest against a sport nature or disciplinary nature, must reach the jury through the referee or other competent officials according to the regulations laid down by the appropriate ISU or by the technical regulations (art. 11.2)..

A Head of Delegation or his deputy has recourse to protest against the decision of the jury. This protest must be submitted in written form to the jury of Appeal in accordance with the regulation of the ISU. Such protest must be accompanied by a deposit of fifty (50) EUR which will be returned if the protest is considered to be justified (art.11.3).

Any decision of the jury of Appeal of a sport is final one and must be reported immediately to the head of delegation of country concerned (art.11.4).

Protest allowed in Article 3.2.2 must be presented to the president or secretary general of FISU, by the Head of Delegation or his deputy in written form not later than six hours after the incident (art. 3.2.7)

A. Technical Data

Single Skating – Men and Ladies

The Announcement with the detailed information has been published on the FISU and ISU website.

Short Program

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010, Rule 511 paragraph 1 and 2 and the respective ISU Communications.

Duration: It should be max. 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less

Free Skating

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2010, Rule 512 and the respective ISU Communications.

Ice Dance Short Dance:

The specified Pattern Dance to be skated is Golden Waltz (61-63 measures of 3 beats per minute) - 1 full sequence of the dance must be performed. The composition of the Short Dance in the season 2010/2011 will contain five (5) Required Elements in total:

2 Required Elements in the Pattern Dance part: 1 sequence of the Golden Waltz is divided into 2 sections and each of these sections is considered as one of the two Required Elements.

3 Required Elements in the Creative part (Short Lift, Midline Not-touching Step Sequence and Set of Sequential Twizzles).

Music for the entire Short Dance (including music for specified Pattern Dance) is provided by the couple and may be vocal.

The choreography of the Creative part may be to the same rhythm as the specific Pattern Dance (Waltz) or to be one or two of the rhythms chosen from the following rhythms: Foxtrot, Quickstep, Tango which can be included in any order.

Duration: It should be 2 minutes and 50 seconds +/- 10 seconds

Free Dance:

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Ice Dancing 2010, Rule 610 and all pertinent ISU Communications. For the value of the required elements and components see the respective ISU Communications.

Duration : 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds

Factors : The multiplying factors for the Program parts for Ice Dance are listed in Rule 353, paragraph 1.n)

Synchronized Skating

The Competition will be held according to ISU Constitutions and General Regulations 2010, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2010 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

Short Program

The prescribed elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2010 Rules 904, 905 paragraph 2-Group A and all pertinent ISU Communications.

Duration: Max 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Synchronized Skating 2010, Rules 911 and 912 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

Duration: 4 minutes and 30 seconds +/- 10 seconds

B. Music

The ISU Rule 343 shall apply. Upon accreditation, all competitors shall furnish their competition music of excellent quality on CD, MD, or in any other approved format.

Two (2) copies for each program must be submitted at the time of accreditation.

The music covers/discs must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time) which shall be certified by the competitor and by the coach when submitted during registration.

Each program (short/free) must be recorded on one track and on a separate disc. Competitors must provide a back-up drive for each program.

C. Program Content Sheet

The program content sheet must be submitted at the time of accreditation. The planned program Content Sheets must be signed by a Coach. However the program contents may be changed at the time of the competition.

The Organizing Committee, in accordance with the Executive Committee and CTI will be allowed to reduce, if demanded by the circumstances, the number of participants to two (2) for each discipline.

Medalists from the previous Winter Universiade may compete in the following Winter Universiade without any application in the allowed number of competitors per country.

The Synchronized Skating Competition may include maximum of eight (8) teams.

A Synchronized Skating Team must consist of sixteen (16) skaters plus four (4) alternates and may include both women and men (art.12.31.5).

Each team may have up to a maximum of twenty six (26) persons accredited.

At the first General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his representative shall confirm and sign the official list of the accredited competitors by the CIC.
